Springfield, IL, February 22, 2013 – The Illinois State Board of Elections has set up a special election day “hotline” telephone number to assist voters at next Tuesday’s Consolidated Primary election, board officials said today.

Election specialists will be available Election Day from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. in Chicago and from 5:30 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. in Springfield to answer voter questions and respond to complaints.
