US Congress District 12

Encompasses parts of Madison County, and entirely encompasses St. Clair, Monroe, Randolph, Perry, Jefferson, Franklin, Jackson, Williamson, Union, Alexander, and Pulaski Counties,
US Congress District 12 begins at a point on the Illinois / Missouri border at the intersection of the Alton / Godfrey Twp border and the Illinois / Missouri border in Madison County,
thence generally north and east along the Alton / Godfrey Twp border to the intersection of W. Delmar Av and Strong Av,
thence north along Strong Av to Harold St,
thence east along Harold St to Tibbitt St,
thence south along Tibbitt St for approximately 50 feet,
thence west for approximately 205 feet,
thence south for approximately 110 feet,
thence east for approximately 230 feet to Tibbitt St,
thence south along Tibbitt St to the Alton / Godfrey Twp border,
thence generally east along the Alton / Godfrey Twp border to Queen St,
thence north along Queen St and continuing north along Queen St (extended) to State Rt 3 (Homer Adams Pky),
thence southeast along State Rt 3 (Homer Adams Pky) to the Alton / Godfrey Twp border,
thence northwest, north, east, south, east and generally north along the Alton / Godfrey Twp border to Big Arch Rd,
thence east along Big Arch Rd and continuing east along Big Arch Rd (extended) for approximately 900 feet,
thence south for approximately 90 feet,
thence southwest for approximately 200 feet,
thence south for approximately 390 feet,
thence southeast for approximately 500 feet,
thence east for approximately 200 feet to a point approximately 16 feet west of the Southern Pacific Gateway Western rail line,
thence southeast running generally parallel to the Southern Pacific Gateway Western rail line for approximately 3240 feet,
thence north for approximately 680 feet,
thence west for approximately 575 feet to the Southern Pacific Gateway Western rail line ,
thence northwest along the Southern Pacific Gateway Western rail line for approximately 2600 feet,
thence east for approximately 180 feet,
thence north for approximately 520 feet,
thence west for approximately 120 feet,
thence northwest for approximately 315 feet to the Alton / Godfrey Twp border,
thence generally east, south and east along the Alton / Godfrey Twp border and continuing along the Alton / Foster Twp border to Humbert Rd,
thence southeast for approximately 850 feet,
thence east for approximately 1920 feet to Seminary Rd,
thence north along Seminary Rd and continuing north, east, south, and east along the Alton / Foster Twp border to appoint approximately 1080 feet east of N. Rodgers Av,
thence south for approximately 360 feet,
thence east for approximately 1830 feet to the West Fork Wood River,

thence generally north along the West Fork Wood River to the Alton / Foster Twp border,
thence southeast along the Alton / Foster Twp border for approximately 1530 feet,
thence east for approximately 1515 feet,
thence north for approximately 1220 feet,
thence east for approximately 1630 feet,
thence south for approximately 430 feet,
thence west for approximately 1130 feet,
thence south for approximately 350 feet,
thence east for approximately 1230 feet,
thence north for approximately 830 feet to the Alton / Foster Twp border,
thence east along the Alton / Foster Twp border for approximately 2300 feet,
thence south for approximately 120 feet,
thence east for approximately 50 feet to Fosterburg Rd,
thence southwest along Fosterburg Rd for approximately 1070 feet,
thence east for approximately 500 feet,
thence north for approximately 100 feet,
thence east for approximately 320 feet,
thence south for approximately 225 feet to Culp Ln,
thence east along Culp Ln to the intersection of Stutz Ln and 14th St,
thence continuing east along the Wood River / Foster Twp border, and continuing east along the Ft
Russell / Moro Twp border to Maple St (the northeast corner of Section 6, T5N, R8W (3rd principal
meridian)),
thence south along the east borders of Sections 6 and 7, T5N, R8W (3rd principal meridian) to the
southeast corner of Section 7, T5N, R8W (3rd principal meridian),
thence west along the south border of Section 7, T5N, R8W (3rd principal meridian) to the Wood River
Twp border,
thence south along the Wood River / Ft Russell Twp border, and continuing south along the Chouteau /
Edwardsville Twp border, and continuing south along the Nameoki / Collinsville Twp border to the St.
Clair County border,
thence east along the St. Clair / Madison County border to the northeast corner of St. Clair County,
thence south along the St. Clair / Clinton County border and continuing south along the St. Clair /
Washington County border to the southwest corner of Washington County,
thence east along the Washington / Randolph County border, and continuing east along the Washington
/ Perry County border to the southeast corner of Washington County,
thence north along the Washington / Jefferson County border to the northwest corner of Jefferson
County,
thence east along the Jefferson / Marion County border to the northeast corner of Jefferson County,
thence south along the Jefferson / Wayne County border, and continuing south along the Jefferson /
Hamilton County border, and continuing south along the Hamilton/ Franklin County border,
and continuing south along the Franklin / Saline County border, and continuing south along the Saline /
Williamson County border to the southeast corner of Williamson County,
thence west along the Williamson / Johnson County border to the northwest corner of Johnson County,
thence south along the Johnson / Union County border and continuing south along the Johnson / Pulaski
County border to the southwest corner of Johnson County,
thence east along the Pulaski / Johnson County border to the Massac County border,
thence south along the Pulaski / Massac County border to the Illinois / Kentucky border,
thence generally southwest to the Illinois / Missouri border,
thence generally northwest along the Illinois / Missouri border to the point of beginning.
