


Illinois Senate District 59

Senate District 59

(Encompasses the entirety of Alexander, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Johnson, Massac, Pope, Pulaski, Saline and Williamson Counties, and partially within Union and Jackson Counties)

Senate District 59 shall include that part of Illinois beginning at the northwest corner of Franklin County, thence east along the north border of Franklin County to the Hamilton County border, thence north along the Hamilton / Jefferson County border to the northeast corner of Hamilton County, thence south along the White/Hamilton County borders to the southwest corner of White County, thence east along the south border of White County to the Indiana border, thence south and southwest along the Illinois / Indiana and Illinois / Kentucky borders, and continuing northwest along the west border of Alexander County (the Missouri border) to the Alexander/Union County border, thence east along the Alexander / Union County border and continuing east along the Pulaski County border to US route 51, thence north/northwest along US 51 to E. Vienna St in Anna, Illinois, thence southwest along E. Vienna St. to McKinley St, thence north along McKinley St to Lincoln St, thence west along Lincoln St to N. Main St, thence southwest along N. Main St to W. Monroe St, thence northwest along W. Monroe St to Grayland Ct, thence south along Grayland Ct to the alley between Monroe and Chestnut Sts, thence northwest along the alley to N. Green St, thence north along N. Green St to W. Monroe St, thence southeast along W. Monroe St to Hendra St, thence north along Hendra St to Casey St, thence east along Casey St to Keller Ct (extended), thence north along Keller Ct (extended) to Keller Ct, thence north along Keller Ct to Kohler St, thence east along Kohler St to Warren St, thence north along Warren St, and continuing north along Warren St (extended) to Young St, thence west along Young St for approximately 60 feet, thence northwest for approximately 530 feet to the west border of Section 17, T12S, R1W (3rd principal meridian), (last 2 on same picture) thence north along the west border of Section 17, T12S, R1W (3rd principal meridian) to the north border of the S ½ of Section 17, T12S, R1W (3rd principal meridian), thence east along the north border of the S ½ of Section 17, T12S, R1W, (3rd principal meridian) to US 51, thence north along US 51 to Potters Rd, thence east along Potters Road and Potters Rd (extended) to the Illinois Central rail line, thence north along the Illinois Central rail line to E. Pleasant Hill Rd in Carbondale, thence west along E. Pleasant Hill Rd to US 51, thence north along US 51 to S. University Av, thence north along University Av to US 51, thence north along US 51 to the northeast spur of the Illinois Central rail line (just south of Ready Mix Rd), thence northeast along the northeast spur of the Illinois Central rail line to the Illinois Central rail line, thence south along the Illinois Central rail line to the Canadian National rail line,

thence northeast along the Canadian National rail line to N. Wall St,
thence south along N. Wall St to E. Green St,
thence east along E. Green St and continuing east along the south border of Section 15, T9S, R1W (3rd
principal meridian) for approximately 1700 feet,
thence south for approximately 800 feet to E. Main St,
thence east along E. Main St to N. Lewis Ln,
thence south along N. Lewis Ln to Old US Hwy 13,
thence east and northeast along Old US Hwy 13 to the Williamson County border,
thence north along the west border of Williamson and Franklin Counties to the point of beginning.
