The Executive Director stated the reason for today's meeting was to certify established party candidates for the March 3, 2009 Special Primary Election ballot in the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. There were fourteen candidates total and he proceeded to name each candidate listed for the Democratic, Republican and Green Parties as listed on the certification. For the record, it was noted that candidates Charles Wheelan, Pete Dagher, Carols Monteagudo, Roger Thompson, III and Rosanna Pulido had objections pending.

Member McGuffage moved to approve the certification pending the outcome of the objections. Vice Chairman Schneider seconded the motion which passed by roll call vote of 8-0.

Member Keith expressed his condolences in the death of Mercer County Clerk, Tom Hanson and suggested the Executive Director send a sympathy letter to the family on behalf of the Board.

With there being no further business before the Board Vice Chairman Schneider moved to adjourn until Thursday, February 5, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. in Springfield, Chicago and Lewis & Clark College via videoconference or until call of the Chairman, whichever occurs first.
